

Runals, Edmund L

Butterfield (1880) page 904:
Attorney; b at Arcade, N Y; studied law but did not practise in that state; came to Section 36 Ripon twp. in Sept., 1846; afterwards lived on Sec. 2 Metomen twp. until 1852; May 1, 1852 came to Ripon village and was elected justice of the peace; in the winter of 1853 and 1854 was engaged in surveying and taking subscriptions for the Milw. & Hor. R R; admitted to the bar in 1854 and began practising law, which he has continued ever since; has carried on farming, tax title and other business in connection with his law practise; has been Supt of Public Schools in Ripon and Metomen, assessor of Ripon twp 3 yrs, in the Assembly in 1857 and 1858, municipal judge four yrs, city attorney 5 yrs, Alderman and supervisor 2 terms; before coming west spent 4 yrs at Bathany and Strykersville in school; m at Lavonia, Mich. July, 1847, Miss Dorlesca Avery, b near Java Lake, N Y; they have one child: Willie T.

Necrol. '85-90 p 109, E L Runals, d July 16, 1888 in terrible agony from inflammation of the bowels; b Dec 18, 1826; "a leading lawyer of research and ability, with strong literary tastes."

'95-99 p 27, Mrs Dora Runals, d Sept 17, 1896 of Bright's disease; 67 yrs old; resided in Ripon since 1852; sole survivor, Willie T, a son.

'85-90 p 52, W T Runals d at Pasadena, Cal. Feb 4, 1921, heart failure; survived by widow and ch.: Dora, Mrs Louis Fox and Guy W of Claremont, Cal Mrs Irene Baird of Scranton, Pa., Wm T Jr of Toledo, Ohio

'31-32 p 93, Mrs W T Runals d at home on Watson St. July 5, 1932; nee Mary S Warner, dau of Wm and Hepsy Warner, b in Chicago Nov 19, 1853; m 1873; charter member of S Wood Park Ass and Ripon Science Club.

Necrol 1948 p 70:

Guy W Runals, d August 3, 1948 at Pomona, California. He was b in February, 1886, in Ripon, Wis. son of the late Willie T Runals and Mary S Werner, his wife, and attended the high school and Ripon College; a member of the Masonic order here, and of the Commandery at Berlin; served some years as an employee of the German National Bank of Ripon; m Miss Laura Cunningham of Berlin, (a Ripon College graduate in 1910,) in 1913, and a few years later they moved to California, where he became an orange grower at Claremont, where he made his home for thirty years; a member of St Paul's Episcopal Ch in Pomona, he was also active in Rotary, serving as its President, and lately as its Secretary, in Claremont. Survived by his widow and one dau. Mrs Paul C Henshaw of Tayoltita, Mexico; also by a brother W T Runals of Akron, Ohio and two sisters: Mrs A J Baird, of Penn. and Miss Dora Runals of Ripon.

'16-17 p 115, James B Baird d at Chattannooga, Tenn (1917?) survived by wife and 4 ch.; their oldest child is buried in Dartford cemetery; owns a beautiful home on Green Lake.
